



PROTECTION of CHILDREN and VULNERABLE ADULTS POLICY STATEMENT

The Stratford-upon-Avon and District Airgun League (SAGL), inclusive of all registered teams, will maintain an environment free from child and vulnerable adult abuse during matches, training sessions, meetings and other associated activities connected with League operations.

SAGL Policy is determined entirely by and compliant with all applicable content of the following policy & guidance document issued by the NSRA;

i) PROTECTION of CHILDREN and VULNERABLE ADULTS in TARGET SHOOTING

SAGL will follow the guidance of the policy in the event of any concerns or allegations.

All League / Team coaches, helpers and officials working with young people or vulnerable adults, during activities associated with SAGL operations, should read and adhere to all applicable content of the National Smallbore Rifle Association Policy and Procedures in respect of the Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults in Target Shooting.

SAGL will identify a person whose role it is to deal with any issues concerning the Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults and notify this person to all members. Anyone with concerns with respect to Abuse or Harassment should contact that person. If that person is unavailable they can contact the League Chairman or the NSRA Child Protection Officer.

SAGL will ensure that anyone working with young people or vulnerable adults within the league undertake a screening procedure (DBS - formally CRB) or be supervised by a screened person.

League Officials and Team Captains give full backing to this Policy and support all those who endeavour to carry it out.
