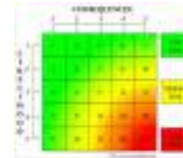




## Return To Shooting under threat from Covid -19

In particular, those who have not been double jabbed & persons who fall into the "clinically vulnerable" bracket should seriously consider their personal circumstances and discuss these with the team captain, if necessary, before returning to shooting. To supplement hand washing facilities at the venue, shooters should bring with them additional hand sanitiser spray/gel for general use whilst at the shooting venue. <b>Comply with your venues Covid-19 requirements.</b> Although, attending a shoot will bring you into contact with members of the general public, who's status is unknown with respect to Covid-19, <b>as a matter of prudence, we are advising</b> shooters to carry out a lateral Flow test and achieve a negative result, within 24hrs of attending a shoot.	1	5

General Operations when at the Venue	All at the venue and those attending shooting	Possible Covid-19 infection	Transmission of infection to others you may come into contact with	4	5	20	<b>Comply with all COVID -19 requirements of the venue where shooting is taking place.</b> It is still advisable to wear a face mask when moving around the venue, unless you are exempt. Within the restricted space of the shooting room, where applicable, avoid crowding together and apply social distancing if possible. It is still advisable to wear a face mask.  Shooting, Loading, Scoring/Painting and sharing Guns - Where possible avoid loading for others and avoid sharing guns. If this is not possible, loaders & shooters should sanitise their hands before touching the gun. Gun sharing, guns should be sanitised after each shooter. It is still advised that Loaders & shooters who are in close proximity and scorer's / painters wear a mask .  Comfort Breaks Avoid un-necessary movement at the venue and be fully aware who is situated around you. Wear your mask when required to do so and try to maintain social distance ing between you and others.	2	10
