Previous Actions completed

 - Andy C has discussed the possibility of producing “copy” for inclusion in the Observer with the Sports Editor, who has provided Andy with some guidelines.

New & Outstanding Actions

- **Competition Organisers** - Create and publish a set of agreed competition rules, inclusive of

measuring technique, covering home and away matches against the Redditch League and the paper target triple 6.

- 14.04.2015. Nothing to report at this time. It would appear that common ground needs to be found on a number of issues, before bad feeling, between teams and indeed shooters, makes it not possible to compete in the future.
- 14.04.2015 – No progress made/reported – **this requires actioning ASAP**
- **Richard** to make contact with Nuneaton/Bedworth Bell Target league to explore possibilities of an inter league shooting match home and away.
 - 14.04.2015 RG has located Jeff's (N&BBTL) contact details and has made contact regarding moving this issue forward. Jeff rang RG back and discussed possibilities for next session. Jeff will pass RG details onto their league chairman / secretary and get him to contact RG to get things moving. RG will report back as things progress.
 - 14.07.2015 - Contact made with N&BBTL but no further progress made. Attempted contact was made with the Hinckley BTL but again no progress has been made.
 - Keep on the action log so it can be revisited at a later date.
- **SAGL Media Representative (Andy Clingan)**
 - Make contact with Local Radio as discussed with respect to our open/guest evening to discuss how this can be advertised.

Discussion Points

1. Shooter Development

- **Formalised training for "League Coaching staff"** was fully discussed again, including the instruction from the League that it will only fund one delegate per team and provide funding of £25 per delegate.
 - RG made it clear that where an organisation requires personnel to take on a responsibility, it is up to that organisation to ensure they are adequately trained and competent to undertake the role. It is also the organisations responsibility to pay for the training and not require the delegate to contribute.
 - Currently the delegates list is as follows;
 - Paul & Andrew Clingan - Graham East – **Wilmcote (all will pay full cost of £45)**
 - Will Cemis & Andrew Smith – **Binton A**
 - Derek Powers - **MEB**
 - Steve Everett – **Avenue**
 - Steve Ray – Rich Groom – Chris Adams **Avon**
 - Steve Hodges – **Binton B**
 - Andy Morris – **Snitterfield** is already trained via the Scouting movement's activities regarding shooting.
 - RG has contacted **Rachel (Clifford Chambers)** and she will ask her team if anyone wants to take part and then get back to him.
- RG will make contact with
 - All concerned to see if they are still interested now the league has imposed a fee of £20 to be paid by each delegate towards the overall fee of £45 pounds per delegate +the cost of the trainer's fuel bill.
 - Once figures have been firmed up RG will contact Trevor Haynes again and progress matters further.
- It was agreed that Wilmcote be used for the training as it reflects the way we shoot – cost of room hire £30 to be paid by the league (need confirmation from League Treasurer on this matter).

2. League Development

- **Marketing** – Having previously discussed the marketing potential of a simple, informative flyer/poster about SAGL and Bell Target shooting, which could be displayed on noticeboards in sports & social clubs, bowls clubs, Henley shooting Club, 8th Warwick's, corner shops, libraries, supermarkets etc.
 - We visited this one again as we think there is potential for advertising our open/guest evening. **See below;**
- **Guest day's / evenings** – Closed Season promotion -
 - The group agreed a date late July / early August 2015 would be ideal to hold an **open day / afternoon event**.
 - **Time set up** 12noon onwards – for a 7pm start
 - **Venue** – Wilmcote – Room available on 15 August 2015 PC/AC to fill in form.
 - **Advertising event** Andy C will put together the poster with a combination of words agreed at the meeting
 - Andy C will also put together, with the help of Juana E, an item for publishing in the observer along with a smaller version of the poster.
 - Andy C will contact Steve R to establish if he can quickly, as we are running out of time, print 25 posters.
 - Andy C will contact our local Radio station as discussed;
 - Possibly involve radio 2-3 weeks prior so there is a build-up of info getting out there – must be guided by them. Costs may be involved which could easily be prohibitive.
 - Involve Social committee with the event – Raffle tickets / contact details of attendees – no food
- **OPEN 6m PAPER Target Shoot – THIS WILL BE THE MAIN SUBJECT MATTER FOR OUR NEXT LDC MEETING. The subject was fully discussed as a means of progressing the league and generating income.**

3. Documentation –

- League Equipment Inventory – Discussed the need to included items owned by the individual teams, detailing what it is and who owns it. This will hopefully prevent equipment being impounded if a venue goes bust. No progress made as such. Need to progress as detailed in the Action list.
