New & Outstanding Actions

1. **Shooter Development** – Attend comps and practice / training. The choice is the shooters
2. **League Development** –
 - **SAGL 2019 Paper Target Challenge (The SPTC) 7.30pm start 9th March 2019**
 - Set up Friday 8th March after 9.30pm
 - Will now be first come first served as far as shooting is concerned.
 - No pre-booking required.

 - RFSG & ADS Range Officers
 - Andy to publish event
 - Andy to revisit the “cut off” to establish if any change is required and the mark up on the classifications on Baildham list.
 - Andy / Paul to make sure room is booked as soon as possible.
 - **6yrd 2019 Paper Target Summer League** - to be held at Wilmcote
 - Same format as last year
 - Classification to be same as SPTC so you shoot against shooter of similar ability
 - Class A – Class B – Class C
 - Event needs publicising – ADS will sort this on web, delegates meeting and newsletter.
 - 5 rounds to be shot, each round consisting of 2 target cards – 8 shots on each card (North Hereford Targets).
 - 10 Cards will be issued, 8 will be stickered the other 2 being your sighter cards.
 - Rounds will be shot during July & August at the shooter's leisure (must shoot both cards on same night)
 - ADS to provide stickers
 - Pre-Entry required by the June delegates meeting - £5 per shooter.

- Room will be set up on Sundays and Thursdays with 2 target holders and a bell target available.
 - Certificates to be produced for presentation night for the winners of each classification.
 - Shot cards must be witnessed and signed before handing in for scoring.
 - Usual trophy & winners' certificate for each class will be provided – Trophy's to be held for a year and returned.
 - We have gauges available and gauging will be like SPTC.
 - Andy Smith will collate the results and enter them on a spreadsheet displayed on the SAGL Website
 - We discussed the possibility of opening this up to both Evesham and Redditch league members. We would need to normalise their averages so they all within our categories, which we dint see as a problem.
 - We need to make contact with both Redditch and Evesham leagues Chairmen to establish if any of their shooters would like to take part and how to apply. RG can either email the Chairmen or we can discuss the summer league at our interleague matches. Discuss further.
- **Over 55's event**
 - Discussed the Game Fair but clearly, we couldn't commit in the professional way we would like. However, we missed out on the Over 55's local event. We need to be aware of this event taking place in Stratford upon Avon in 2019 and make every effort to take part. This we can handle.
- **New Shooter Generation**
 - Advertising Campaign (All were very impressed with Lester's efforts on the new poster – Thank you)
 - **Using Face Book** – Andy to put new poster on SAGL FB page. All shooters then to share it.
 - Speak with Steve Ray to see if his people have any additional ideas.
 - This to be done every quarter
 - Paul C to ask Lester if he can re-jig the poster so each quarters post is slightly different.
 - **Stratford Forum** – Jo, if she's a member, to up load a poster to the forum every quarter.
 - **Juana's Newspaper reports** to have contact details re-instated if they are currently missing. If they get published great if not nothing lost.
 - **Teams need to be more proactive** in encouraging new members, where the possibility arises and to meet with the new potential team members on a Sunday Evenings at Wilmcote where further introductions / inductions can take place along with them having a go.
- Competitions - Why are they not well supported? We had a full discussion on the subject.
 - Currently, we provide the members with various competitions – League, Webley, Various Cup Comps, SPTC, SAGL PT Summer League and Back to Basics.
 - These reflect what SAGL is about, respect the past and past membership but as a group, which needs to evolve to survive, we embrace change.
 - By Embracing change, we must respect the past and not diminish any competitions status.
 - This is something we feel ALL league members should have a voice and with this in mind Andy will, using SAGL Face Book page, publish questions enabling members to respond.
 - We feel we have the right comps in place, maybe we need a bit more Razzmatazz – Maybe try this for the Whitbread or the Pairs in 2019.
 - Maybe we hold them on Saturday nights and include food as well.

We need to hear from what the league members want, not what we think they want!!!
