- 1. APOLOGIES: W Cemis, A McMillan
- 2. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING read & agreed
- 3. MATTERS ARISING Paul Clingan reported that he had given Richard Mills 2 target plates.
- 4. SAFETY (RG) Re gun power & splashback. Research revealed other leagues limited their power to 7lb. P Clingan has chronograph to measure the power of air rifles & he has been testing some rifles at Wilmcote over the past 2 weeks. He will send invitation to League Facebook page for those who would like to check their guns on the equipment, building up a broad spectrum of the guns. If successful, could recommend a league limit at next AGM.
