9 League Development Committee:-

9.1 The SAGL Paper Target challenge was held on Saturday March 19th at Wilmcote SSC. 14 entrants took part. The event was staged as a way of encouraging league members to have a go at paper target shooting. The results will be used as a selection process for the "Triple Six" inter league competition.

The competition ran well, with shooting taking place under range officer control, and silence whilst shooting took place. The results are on the web site. The classification grouping worked perfectly and no changes will be made to this method.
