There had been a proposal at June 2019 Delegates meeting for some of the money saved from buying individual replica trophies (about £400) could go towards paying for the engraving of the 18 trophies (approx £180).

Action: Could everyone in possession of a trophy please contact Jo Langford with details of how up to date they are, then we could arrange for all trophies to be taken together to be updated and engraved.

c) PC asked what we were planning to do to celebrate the 110th anniversary of the League. JL suggested we ask Juana Everett to approach Stratford Herald to come along to one of our events and take photographs to publish in the weekly newspaper. A good opportunity would be the Alcester 41 visit.
